One of these cultural treasures is the variety of souvenirs found in each region, which reflect their respective characteristics. Souvenirs have a very important role as a face or characteristic and heritage of a particular area, which functions as a real marker that encapsulates the essential historical value of a place, including its traditions and heritage. In Indonesia, each region has its own souvenirs, embodying local customs, craftsmanship and available natural resources.

This final project aims to develop a web-based application that promotes traditional Indonesian souvenirs by incorporating geolocation features to provide real-time positioning and information about nearby souvenir store.
