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

If initially men's shoes, such as pump shoes or oxfords, and women's such as high heels, were the trendsetters, nowadays what is growing rapidly is the sneaker model that can be used for both formal and nonformal events. One of the pioneers of sneakers is Converse. This study reveals that the drivers of perceived value are brand image, price, and retail service quality to compete and win the competition among sneakers' companies. It also reveals that ADAM perceived value increases customer satisfactions and at the same time increases loyalty. Hence, satisfaction is not the only driver to increase customer loyalty of the Converse shoe store in Summarecon Mal Bekasi. This study was conducted applying the quantitative method since it is a consumer behavior study. This study suggests Convers footwear stores to provide varieties type and price to suit differen demography profiles.
